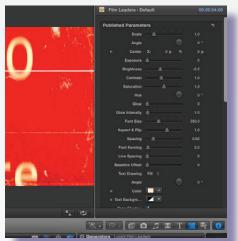




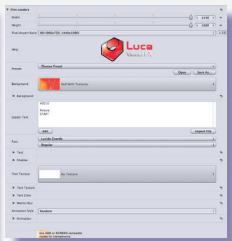
Luca's Film Leaders

Film Leaders is a powerful and versatile plugin that allows the user to seemingly adjust every aspect of the effect. You create its look and you choose what the leader says. Type in your desired text, pick your font, choose text textures, or a plain color, add effects, select a background or have it without, tweak the animation controls to create your own film leader and there you go, your unique and dynamic film leader is ready to use. There are so many useful controls you can even create original animated text going beyond the look of a traditional leader. Furthermore the plugin comes with more than 50 presets you can start from!

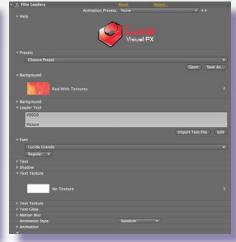
This generator is compatible with Final Cut Pro 6.0 and 7.0, Final Cut Pro X, Final Cut Express 4.0 or later, Apple Motion 3.0 or later, Premiere Pro CS 6 and Adobe After Effects 8.0 or later (Premiere Pro users please see page 13 for further instructions). To install simply unzip the downloaded file and double click the icon. Restart the software and you are ready to go.

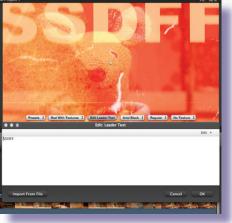

Film Leaders enable you to change and adjust:

Presets Choose a pre-made leader, to use as a starting point,

from a great number of suggested looks shipping with the plugin. These can be customized to your needs and represent a great way to find out the possibilities of Film

Leaders.

Background Fine tune the look of the leader background. Select one

of the provided BGs, alternatively use a BG-free

leader or edit your own BG.

Text Select your word, font*, font size, color, text drawing and

adjust your line spacing, font kerning, and angle.

Shadow Add shodow to your type.

Text TextureControl the texture of your type (Keep the "Plain" option if

you wish to have a texture-free text).

Text Glow Add glow to you text.

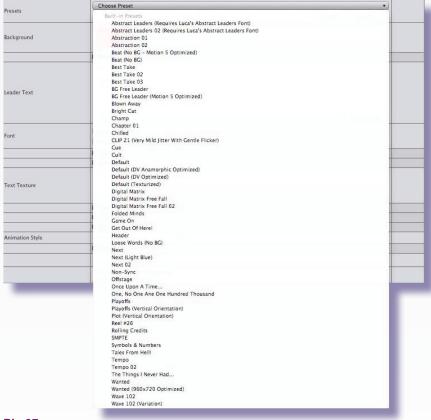
Motion Blur Decide how much motion blur you need.

Animation Adjust the amount of vertical, horizontal and rotational

movement of your leader.

Presets

The Presets menu allows you to apply a stylized film leader to your project without having to fiddle necessarily with the parameters. You can either apply the preset of your choice and use it as it is or make any desired adjustment such as changing the **text, animation style**, **texture exposure**, **motion blur**, **background** etc.



^{*}Please note: Luca Visual FX provides you with one customized abstract font (Luca's Abstract Font) however you can create your own fonts using third party software and place it in your fonts library. We also recommend to download and use free or purchased nice Grungy Fonts.

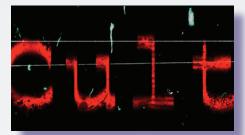

Background

Choose from a selection of backgrounds for your leader. Each one different from the next to suit your project's needs. Use the controls provided to radically change its appearance (**Hue** parameter, **Motion Blur** etc.). If desired the user may simply choose not to use one of the BGs provided and underlay her own.

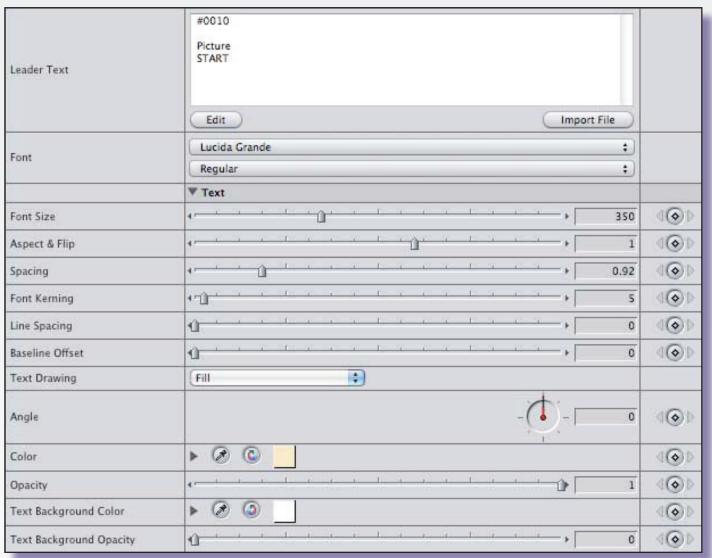

Text

Luca's Film Leaders allows you to change the text within the leader to any word or even sentence and number of lines you need. Not only this, you may also select any font from your font library to use in the leader.

*FCP X Users can now customize Text, Texture, Background etc. thanks to the new OSC (On Screen Controls). FxFactory 3.0.3 required. See Pic 04, 05 & 06.

Leader Text
Font
Font Size
Type what you want the leader text to say.
Select from a variety of fonts from your system.
Set the size of your font.

•Aspect & Flip Change the aspect ratio of your type. Negative values will allow the text to flip horizontally.

Spacing
Font Kerning
Line Spacing
Allows you to distance or overlap text.
Set the line kerning of your text.
Set the line spacing of your text.

•Baseline Offset Set the position of the type in relation to the baseline.

•Text Drawing Select to have the text with fill, stroke or both.

•Angle Adjust the angle of the type.

•Color Set the color of your type*.

Set the opacity of your type.

Add a colored background to your type.

Set the background opacity of the type.

Shadow

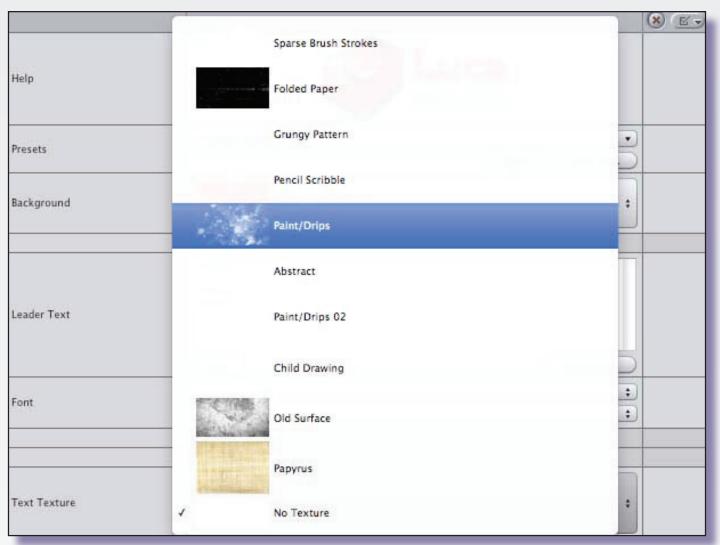
Set the shadow opacity.

Text Texture

Add texture to your type by selecting the type of texture, determining the exposure, distorting the texture's X and/or Y axis and adjusting the alpha threshold and/or sharpness.

There are two types of textures provided, some with transparency and others without. Those with transparency may in some circumstances, when selected, give the impression that the text has disappeared. In those circumstances the user should use the distort and threshold controls to adjust the texture within the font (also use invert alpha check box when appropriate).

^{*} Please note. A high value of exposure may effect the color you choose

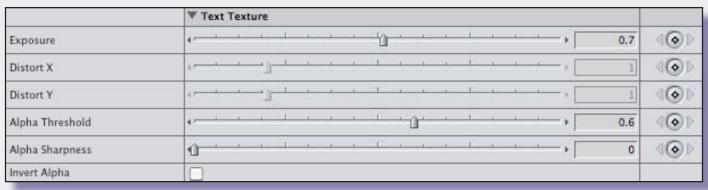

Text Texture Controls:

•**Text Texture** Select the texture to apply on the text.

•Exposure Set the exposure of the texture. This will affect the color

of the leader.

•Distort X Distort the X axis.

•Distort Y Distort the Y axis.

•Alpha Threshold Adjust the alpha threshold. •Alpha Sharpness Adjust the alpha sharpness.

•Invert Alpha Select to invert the alpha channel.

Please note that the **Exposure** parameter may affect the color of your leader. Exposure amount is particularly relevant when using one of the **text textures**.

Text Glow

Adjust the amount of glow of your text.

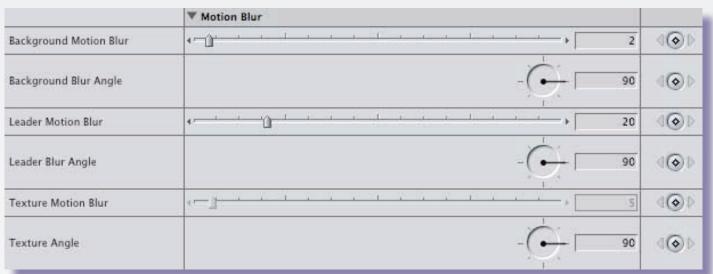

Motion Blur

One of the characteristics of a leader is that they occur at different intensities and speed. By taking advantage of the Motion Blur controls you can determine the amount of distortion and blurriness that is realistically produced during the effect. You can apply motion blur to background, leader text and text texture. (see Pic 45)



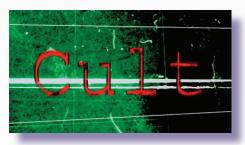

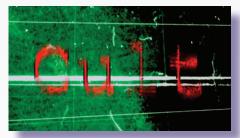








Pic 47. Background Blur

Motion Blur Controls:

•Background Motion Blur Adjust the amount of background motion blur.

Background Blur Angle
Leader Motion Blur
Set the angle of the background blur.
Change the motion blur of the leader.

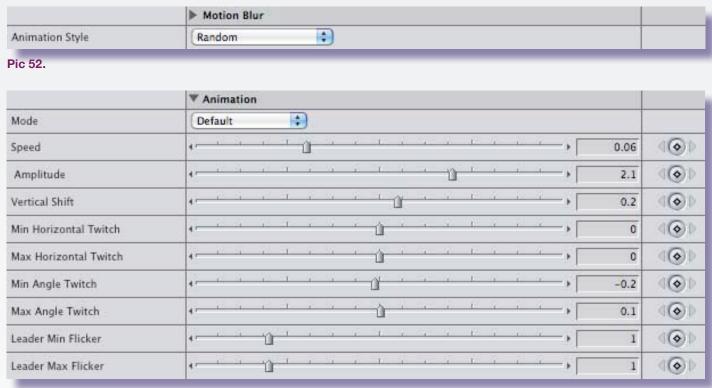
•Leader Blur Angle Set the blur angle for the leader blur.

•Texture Motion Blur Set the motion blur for the texture.

•Texture Angle Set the angle of the texture blur.

Animation

The user can determine the position and animation style of the leader by horizontally and vertically adjusting and twitching it. It is also possible to animate the angle. The plugin comes with several **Animation Styles** and modes, allowing the text to roll up, roll down or move at random.



Pic 53.

Pic 51 and 52 show how you can horizontally and vertically reposition your text. **Vertical Shift** slider controls the vertical positioning. Setting **Min Horizontal Twitch** and **Max Horizontal Twitch** to the same value will simply produce a horizontal shift. Any slight or major change in either min or max horizontal twitch will produce a shaky horizontal animation.

Leader Animation Controls:

•Animation Style Choose the style of the animation such as random, up up

down, down down up, wave and others.

•Mode Set the mode, choose between random twitch or a

smoother roll up or roll down

•Speed Control the speed of the animation. The lower the value

the faster the animation.

•Amplitude* Adjust the amplitude. The higher the value, the greater

the vertical distance of the text movement. Set the value

to 0 to have a steady text.

•Vertical Shift** Allows you to reposition the leader vertically.

•Min Horizontal Twitch Determine the minimum random horizontal amplitude in

relation to the Max Horizontal Twitch.

•Max Horizontal Twitch Determine the maximum random horizontal amplitude in

relation to the Min Horizontal Twitch.

•Min Angle Twitch Set the minimum randomness of the rotation on the Y

axis in relation to the Max Angle Twitch.

•Max Angle Twitch Set the maximum randomness of the rotation on the Y

axis in relation to the Min Angle Twitch.

•Min Rotation Twitch Set the minimum rotation twitch.

•Leader Min Flicker Make the text flicker. Use the slider to set the on-duration

of the flicker effect.

•Leader Max Flicker Make the text flicker. Use the slider to set the off-duration

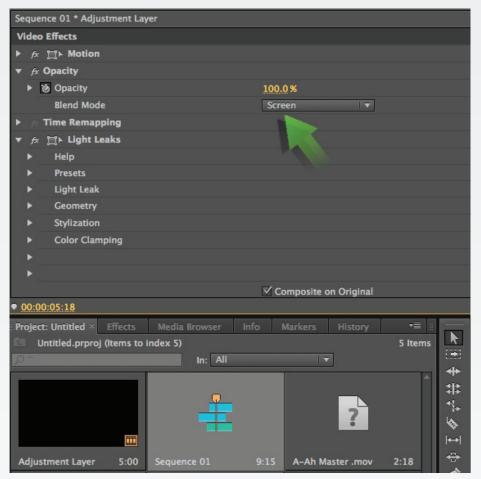
of the flicker effect.

^{*} Important note: The closer the values are to 0 the more subtle the animation becomes, when setting all values to 0 the leader will not move at all.

^{* **} If you wish to create an effect whereby the leader appears in frame, stays for a few instants then disappears out of frame use keyframes for **Amplitude** and **Vertical Shift** parameters.

Premiere Pro users

When using Film Leaders inside Premiere Pro, apply the generator to an adjustment layer placed on top of your video and select/use 'SCREEN' Blend Mode to get rid of the black background.
